POSSESSION OF DRUG PARAPHERNALIA, POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA, CARRYING CONCEALED WEAPON

and was paroled or conditionally released on MAY 1, 1991

and has made a satisfactory adjustment, the Parole Commission, by authority of Sections 15A-1372 (c)/148-49. 15(b) of the General Statutes of North Carolina, does hereby grant to said Offender an Unconditional Discharge from sentence.

### FOR CONVICTED FELONS ONLY — RESTORATION OF RIGHTS

Under Title VII, Sections 1201-02, of the "Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968", the attached certificate of Restoration of Rights of Citizenship **does not** entitle you to own, possess, receive, buy, or otherwise acquire firearms of **any description**. If you are found in violation of the above Federal Act, you are subject to a fine of not more than \$10,000.00 or imprisonment for not more than two years or both.

The Parole Commission does hereby certify that, pursuant to Sections 13.1/13.2/148-49.15(d) of the General Statutes of North Carolina, all rights of citizenship which the said GREGORY ..... WILLIAMSON forfeited on conviction are by law automatically restored.
